

# Memorandum of Agreement

between the  
Webster Central Schools District  
and the  
Webster Teachers Association

Whereas the Webster CSD has chosen to implement a new technology program, "Project Lead the Way" beginning in the 2015-2016 school year, and that any teachers of this program must be appropriately trained and certified, and

Whereas the training for this program can be completed either as 10 full working days during the summer, or as a mixture of release days and weekend work days during the regular school year, and

Whereas various forms of summer training and workshops arranged through the Webster Professional Learning Center pay teachers for their attendance at the training rate of \$150 per day,


Therefore it is

Agreed that technology teachers who voluntarily attend the 2 weeks (10 working days) of summer training for the program, shall have all workshop costs paid by the District, and shall be compensated by the district at the rate of \$150 per day for each day of training attended. Furthermore, it is

Agreed that technology teachers who voluntarily participate in the January option of training will have all the workshop costs paid by the District, shall be granted release days to attend the weekday training sessions, and shall be compensated by the district at the rate of \$150 per each day of training attended on weekends.
